

# Ellen Adele Homan

July 15, 1941 - January 9, 2023



Ellen Adele Homan (nee Schuler) passed away at home on January 9, 2023, after a brief, but intense battle with cancer.

She is survived by Patrick, her husband of nearly 60 years, her brother Bill, and her six children: Katie Noschang (Rob), Mary Siefke (Steve), Barry Homan (Shellie), Matthew Homan (Rebecca), Sarah Homan, and Joe Homan. She was also a grandmother of 17 and a great-grandmother of one.

Born to Edward and Adele Schuler, she grew up in Cincinnati, attending St. Mary's School and St. Ursula Academy before earning a B.A. from the University of Cincinnati. She became an Army wife upon marrying Patrick in 1963, and for the next 15 years lived in Fort Knox, Kentucky; Frankfurt, Germany; Fort Sill, Oklahoma; and Fort Bliss, Texas. She spent the majority of this time at Fort Sill, where she was active in the local Girl Scout Council and the parents' association for St. Mary's School in Lawton, including running spaghetti dinners. After the family moved back to Cincinnati in 1978, she continued her involvement in her children's activities and the community, from supporting local Catholic school parents' associations to helping the local model railroading club organize conventions. Outside of her family and friends, she loved classical music, jazz, opera, reading - especially mysteries - and crossword puzzles. A huge football fan, she cheered on the hometown Bengals and Bearcats, as well as rooted for the Reds. She also enjoyed dogs, and her household nearly always had one around. She was an excellent hostess and cook, and she loved gathering family together for a meal. Above all, she was a wonderful wife, a great mom, and a loving grandmother.

Visitation will take place on Friday, January 13, from 11:00 AM until Noon at St. Rose Church, 2501 Riverside Drive, which will be followed immediately by a Mass of Christian Burial in celebration of her life.
